

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to receive funds from the Good Shepherd Senior Emergency Relief Fund, Parishioners must:

- 1. Be a registered Good Shepherd parishioner for at least six months prior to applying for assistance.
- 2. Be at least 65-years-old. Proof of age is required.
- 3. Complete a Good Shepherd Senior Emergency Relief Fund application and provide Good Shepherd Catholic Community with information relating to household income and expenses.

Please note the following:

- In most cases, Good Shepherd provides financial assistance by paying an outstanding bill directly to the organization to which it is owed, or by providing the senior parishioner with a gift card for gasoline or groceries.
- Parishioners can request financial assistance through the Good Shepherd Senior Emergency Relief Fund quarterly only and no more than four times in one year.
